"I shall fear no evil for you are with me." Psalm 23:4

We are living in difficult times. People worldwide are fearful and unsure of the future. According to the Bible, things will not get better on the earth; they will actually get worse. Paul warned Timothy, "in the last days perilous times shall come" (2 Timothy 3:1). Perils on the earth include natural disasters, diseases, violence and wickedness. The book of Romans tells us the earth is in a state of "For we know that the whole travail. creation groans and labors with birth pangs together until now" (Romans 8:22 NKJV). With all the difficulties and tragedies happening in the world, you might be asking yourself, "Can God protect me from evil?" The answer is definitively, "Yes He can!" and "Yes He will!"

DWELL IN SAFETY

As a believer, you can have full confidence that God will protect you. Paul told the Thessalonian church that, "the Lord is faithful; he will strengthen you and guard you from the evil one" (2 Thessalonians 3:3). God's Word promises us peace and safety. Psalm 4 tells us, "I will both lie down in peace, and sleep; For You alone, O LORD, make me dwell in safety" (Psalm 4:8). True peace and safety can be found in God alone. There is a place of protection every believer can dwell in. The psalmist explains this in Psalm 91, which is our "Protection Psalm."

"He who dwells in the secret place of the Most High Shall abide under the shadow of the Almighty. I will say of the LORD, 'He is my refuge and my fortress; My God, in Him I will trust." (Psalms 91:1-2 NKJV)

What does it mean to "dwell"? It means you are residing in a particular place. Your dwelling is the place where you live and abide. Dwelling in the "secret place" means you are living with God every day, not just visiting Him on Sundays. The secret place is also translated as "shelter." It is a place in God where you are hidden from all dangers, even from your enemy.

UNDER HIS WINGS

Psalm 91:4 says we are safely hidden under his wings. God's heart is to protect us and watch over us. When we truly understand his care for us, we can be free from fear. When Jesus walked the earth, He described his longing to watch over and protect His people. "O Jerusalem, Jerusalem... How often I wanted to gather your children together, as a gathers her chicks under her hen wings.." (Matthew 23:37 NK/V). In other Scriptures, God is described like an eagle or a bird that covers us with His wings and feathers. "He will cover you with his wings; you will be safe in his care; his faithfulness will protect and defend you." (Psalm 91:4 GNT) Also in Isaiah, we find this description: "Like birds hovering, so will the Lord of hosts defend Jerusalem; He will protect and deliver it, He will pass over and spare and preserve it" (Isaiah 31:5 AMPC). These Scriptures can bring us great comfort during times of danger. We can use them to picture ourselves under God's wing of protection.

RESIST FEAR

As God's children, we are to stay in close fellowship with him daily. Living with God ensures we will enjoy His protection. He promises to do His part, but we must also do our part. God commands us not to fear. *"Fear not, for I am with you." (Isaiah 41:10)* Fear is the opposite of faith. Fear is like a spiritual magnet that draws negative forces into your life. For example, let's learn a lesson from the life of Job. After Job experienced a series of devastating events, he made this statement: "the thing I dreaded has happened to me, and what I feared has

come upon me" (Job 3:25 NET). Dread and fear will open the door for the enemy. What we say is very critical. Let's look at Psalm 91 again to see how we can speak faith-filled words. "I will say of the Lord, 'He is my refuge, my safety, my God in whom I will trust" (Psalm 91:2). We have to say something in the face of fear. We can choose to respond in faith or in fear. We can yield to fear or reject it. We might still feel afraid, but let's choose to be courageous and face fear with God's Word. Speak faith-filled words like David who declared, "I shall fear no evil" (Psalm 23:4). Another Scripture to confess is Psalm 91:3,"He will keep (me) safe from all hidden dangers and from all deadly diseases" (GNT). Personalize these Scriptures and confess them over yourself and family, especially in the season we are living in!

STAY IN FAITH

The Apostle Peter wrote to the believers to encourage them during a time of great persecution. He admonishes
