MAKING RIGHT DECISIONS



JUNE 2026

"Thousands upon thousands are waiting in the valley of decision. There the day of the Lord will soon arrive." (Joel 3:14 NLT)

Making right decisions is important for our lives. Your decisions determine your direction, and your direction ultimately determines your destination. Wrong decisions today will make life more difficult tomorrow. Procrastinating or putting off your decision is not a solution. Your decisions affect your own peace and happiness and will even affect the well-being of your loved ones. Proverbs 28:12 says, "when the godly succeed, everyone is glad". (NLT) As free moral agents, we are free to make our own decisions, but God urges us to make the right ones. In Deuteronomy 30:19 He says, "Today I have given you the **choice between life and death, between blessings and curses... Oh, that you would choose life, so that you and your descendants might live!**" (NLT) God wants us to choose life and blessing.

WRONG DECISIONS ARE COSTLY

Let's look at an example of a wrong decision from the life of Paul. When sailing on a ship to Rome, Paul was alerted in his spirit about the disaster ahead. "Men," he said, "I believe there is trouble ahead if we go on—**shipwreck, loss of cargo, and danger to our lives as well.**" (Acts 27:10) Despite Paul's warnings, the captain proceeded with the voyage. They encountered a terrible storm which ultimately caused their shipwreck. Paul told them, "Men, you should have listened to me in the first place and not left Crete. **You would have avoided all this damage and loss.**" (Acts 27: 21 NLT) Even though their lives were spared, great devastation and financial loss resulted. Wrong decisions can be costly. It's vital that we seek God's guidance before making important decisions.

GOD PROMISES TO LEAD US

"The Lord says, 'I will **guide** along the best pathway for your life. I will **advise** you and **watch over** you.'" (Psalms 32:8 NLT) God promises to guide and advise us. We must be open to his guidance and listen for his direction. The next

verse gives us a warning: "Do not be like a senseless **horse or mule** that needs a bit and bridle to keep it under control." (Psalms 32:9 NLT) The Passion Translation makes it even more plain: "So don't make it difficult; don't be stubborn when I take you where you've not been before. **Don't make me tug you and pull you along. Just come with me!**" (Psalms 32:9 TPT) We must be willing to follow His lead. Remember, God won't ever force you to follow Him. He wants to provide direction for every part of our lives. "The Lord directs the steps of the godly. He delights in **every detail** of their lives." (Psalms 37:23 NLT) He has a good plan and a good destiny for all of us. He wants to lead us out of sin, sickness and distress into a life of forgiveness, health and abundance. "You guide me with your counsel, **leading me to a glorious destiny.**" (Psalm 73:24 NLT)

HOW HE LEADS

The primary way God leads us is through His Word. "Your word is a lamp to guide my feet and a light for my path." (Psalm 119:105 NLT) Growing in knowledge about godly principles will help guide your decisions. As New Testament believers we are not to depend on prophets, prophecies or external signs to lead us. In the Old Testament, people depended on natural signs to confirm God's leading, such as Gideon's experience with the fleece. (See Judges 6:36-40) The Lord promises to lead all believers through their spirit. "For all who are **led by the Spirit** of God are children of God." (Romans 8:14 NLT) The Holy Spirit dwells in our recreated born-again spirit and gives us a "witness" or a confirmation when making decisions. Romans 8:16 says, "**the Spirit bears witness with our spirit**". When making important decisions, we need to take time to listen for His voice, which is often a still quiet voice. Jesus assured us that we would know His voice. "My sheep **hear my voice, and I know them, and they follow me.**" (John 10:27 KJV)

STEPS TO MAKE YOUR DECISION

1. Decide to hear from God yourself. Don't depend on others or blame them for your decision. "Do not trust in a friend; Do not put your confidence in a companion." (Micah 7:5 NKJV) Jesus warned us not to be led by blind guides. "They are blind guides leading the blind...they will both fall into a ditch." (Matthew 15:14 NLT)
2. Declutter your heart to hear God clearly. Clean out any hindrances (ie. unforgiveness, disobedience, guilt). "Guard your heart above all else..." (Proverbs 4:23 NLT)

3. Ask for wisdom to make the right decision. "If you need wisdom, ask our generous God, and he will give it to you." (James 1:5 NLT)
4. Humble yourself to follow God's will as He directs you. "He leads the humble in doing right, teaching them his way." (Psalms 25:9 NLT)

"I am the lord your God, who teaches you what is good for you and leads you along the paths you should follow. (Isaiah 48:17 NLT)
